

Reflections 3 on Steinitz Open

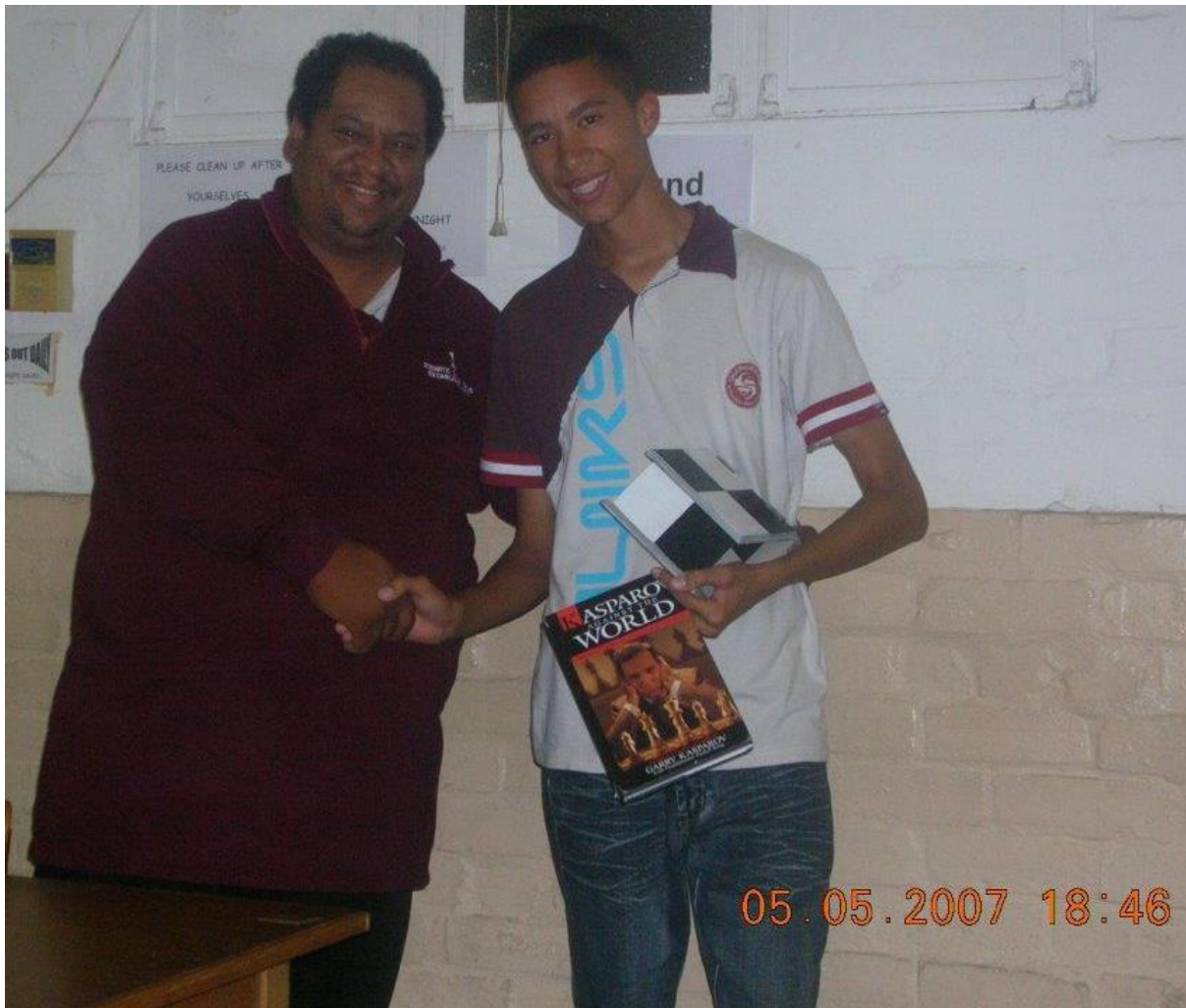
The Cape Town Classic went off very successfully this past weekend. Chess in Cape Town is in full swing.
